Jackson Square Partners Cookie Policy

This policy explains how Jackson Square Partners, LLC (“JSP”) uses cookies on our websites and online services, and the choices you have. This cookie policy provides you with clear and comprehensive information about the cookies we use and the purposes for using cookies. How We Use Cookies

As is common practice with almost all professional websites, the JSP website uses cookies. A “cookie” is a small file that is automatically saved on your computer by your web browser when you visit a website or open certain email messages. Each time you visit a page on that particular website, your web browser sends this cookie back to the website server.

We use both “session cookies” which only function during a specific browsing session and “persistent cookies” which are saved on your device and allow us to recognize you when you return to the site in the future.

We use cookies to recognize visitors and track which parts of our website you visit. The information collected through our cookies may also be used to estimate the size of our visitor community, to analyze trends and general usage patterns of our website, to ensure that our website is efficiently designed, and for other research and marketing purposes. This is summarized statistical information only and does not include any information that could identify an individual.

You can control which types of cookies you allow by changing your web browser settings. You can also use your browser settings to receive notices when new cookies are set, to turn cookies on or disable them entirely and to clear your browser’s history. Unless you have adjusted your browser settings to refuse cookies, we will issue cookies when you visit our website, for the purposes set out above. If you change the cookies settings on your browser, we will ask for your consent to use cookies the next time you visit our website.

You may also encounter cookies on our websites, applications and services that are placed by third parties (such as Google and YouTube).
